

Gretton Parish Council Village Survey Questionaire 2020

ABOUT THE SURVEY

The Village Survey is one of the ways the Parish Council ensures that the work it does meets the needs of village residents. This is the third village survey - previous surveys were held in 2006 and 2014. It helps to set the programme of work for two Parish Council cycles. Not everything we ask about is within the power of the Council to resolve but we work closely with Tewkesbury Borough Council and the Gloucestershire County Council to resolve issues.

As in the previous surveys we are asking about the village environment, housing needs and housing development, our local community and traffic, transport and highways. One way to address many of the issues is through a neighbourhood plan and we give information about this and ask opinions on a separate page of the survey.

HOW TO COMPLETE THE SURVEY

- The survey is completed anonymously but we ask for a postcode to help us to analyse it.
- Most questions just require you to tick a box.
- There are write in sections where you can identify specific issues or give your opinions.
